Find out and prevent juvenile violence and raise the awareness of juveniles of their rights.

Project Beneficiaries

Juveniles from 32 communities of Sisian Goris, Kapan areas of RA Syunik region.

Results

Within the framework of the project, sociological surveys were conducted among 6-12th grade pupils, teachers and residents (parents, other members) of the project beneficiary schools, to find out cases of juvenile violence, as well as the attitude of the respondents towards the sanctions applied to children.

In the project implementation process, P & T NGO has included members of the Syunik Student Council Network, who have been actively involved in all the processes since the launch of the project. To present the results of the survey a forum on “ Juvenile violence cases, and the mechanisms of their prevention in RA Syunik region” was held in Goris.

Among the guests of the forum were: members and consultants of Syunik Student Council Network, workers of “World Vision Sisian and Kapan” ADP, representatives of family, women and children's rights protection departments of regional administration of Syunik, human rights NGOs of Syunik region, juvenile inspectors, psychologists, social workers, teachers, parents, LG representatives, journalists, community development support center/ CDSN member organizations. As a result of the forum, a package of proposals for the prevention of juvenile violence has been developed with the participation of stakeholders.

Within the framework of the project, the Syunik SC network has carried out informational posters in all beneficiary communities through awareness-raising campaigns entitled "My Right to Live Without Violence" during which community members distributed information leaflets in communities. Within the framework of the program, a special edition of Ardzagank newspaper of Syunik SC Network has been published

Results

Within the framework of the project Yerevan high school №127 was partially renovated: the entrance of the school, the first floor corridor, 6 bathrooms. The school entrance has been adapted for disabled children.

To raise the awareness of sanitary and hygienic standards of consultative bodies, P&T NGO has conducted awareness raising trainings with the participation of students, teachers and parents of the school. As a result of the project, the sanitary facilities of Yerevan high school No. 127 correspond to international standards.

Good changes have encouraged teachers, students and parents. The attendance of pupils from other schools to high school No. 127 has increased. The entrance of the school has become more convenient for pupils, parents and teachers.

The project had a very positive effect on the school's rating. During one year the attendance of pupils increased by 10%.

The implementation of the initiative supposed the preparation and distribution of special edition of "Kamq+" newspaper on the coverage of community enlargement in all the regions of RA. "Kamq+" newspaper prepared in the result of the project includes also attitudes and viewpoints of RA Ministry of Territorial Administration, individual experts, representatives of public sector, relevant departments of regional administrations, community governors and representatives of non-formal groups on the future reformations.

Different arguments and viewpoints on community enlargement reformation helped the reader to specify his/her viewpoint on community enlargement by combining advantages and possible risks.

Special edition of "Kamq+" targeted towards the coverage of community enlargement had a circulation of 2000 copies within RA through regional administrations and municipalities.

Results

In the scope of “support to civil society and local government” project, P&T NGO community development team have coordinated community development processes implementing in 16 beneficiary communities of Syunik and Vayots Dzor regions.

P & T NGO has provided material, technical and administrative support to beneficiary communities of Syunik and Vayots Dzor regions to implement community-directed activities.

Within the framework of the project community active groups and community youth initiative clubs have been formed in beneficiary communities with the help of which beneficiary communities have come up with community-based proposals.

The donor organization has funded a total of 6.2 million AMD in projects presented by urban communities (local government incentive projects) and the investments of LGs made up 40% of the requested amount.

Two different project were implemented in rural communities: community development and civic initiatives grant project (donor contribution 1.7 million AMD , local government contribution more than 20%) and local government incentive project (donor contribution 3.5 million drams, LG contribution more than 40%).

Such participatory, joint approaches to the implementation of the projects served as basis for all community programs to be launched and to be completed successfully.

In the scope of the project, P&T NGO supports beneficiary communities in planning civic initiatives and community development projects by providing close co-operation between community working groups, NGOs, LG and private sector.

Within the framework of 2012-2014 grant project, beneficiary communities were awarded Community Development, Civic Initiatives and LG incentive grants, in the scope of which communities came forward initiatives targeted towards community issues.

P&T NGO “Kamq+” newspaper has consistently illustrated the initiatives of community active groups and community youth initiative clubs.

Results

During 2014-2015 P&T NGO continued its cooperation with World Vision Armenia's Sisian and Kapan ADPs.

Within the framework of the project, P&T NGO continued to develop the Student Council networking activities during 2014-2015 by implementing summer and autumn schools targeted towards Syunik SC Network members capacity building.

Within the framework of the Partnership, forums , with the participation of stakeholders, were held in the field of education, health care, LG and youth employment.

As a result of the regional forums, proposal packages, targeted towards the above mentioned areas have been processed and addressed to decision makers of relevant areas.

*Sub-project

Initiatives implemented by Community Development Support Network / CDSN member organizations:

In the scope of World Vision Sisian ADP cooperation, CDSN member organizations: “Goris Press Club”, “Rights Information Center”, “Sose Women’s issues” and “Goris New Generation” have implemented 2 coalition projects during 2014, April-July.

1. “Goris Press Club” and “Rights Information Center” NGOs implemented "I Participate in My Community Development" coalition project. The project aimed at supporting five rural communities in Goris and Sisian to develop flexible tax collection mechanisms.

As a result of the project, a study was conducted on the tax policy of Halidzor, Harzhis and Ashotavan Communities of Syunik Region, after which a report was prepared. Three videos on tax collection objectives and importance have been prepared for targeted community awareness. A community incentive scheme has been developed to provide community budget revenues.

2. "Sose Women Issues" and "Goris New Generation" NGOs have implemented the "Healthy Childhood" project. The project was aimed at promoting health care of pre-school institution children from Qarahunj, Shinuhayr, Angeghakot and Shaki communities of Syunik region.

As a result of the project, the participation of parent council in solving children health care issues in pre-school institutions, has been increased. The level of control over primary health care services has been increased by the regional authorities.

Contribute to the reduction of youth unemployment in Syunik region by promoting the youth competitiveness in the labor market.

Project Beneficiaries

Direct beneficiaries of the project are young people from World Vision target communities of Goris and Sisian and indirect beneficiaries include young people from all communities of RA Syunik region.

Results

Within the framework of the project, an online e-mail platform was created: www.svunikjob.am, for employers, unemployed people and organizations delivering educational services.

Guideline procedures have been developed which were targeted towards young people's work practice and voluntary work.

As a result of cooperation between Territorial Employment Centers of Sisian and Goris and employers, internship and specialization opportunities have been given to the young people of Syunik region.

- As a result of cooperation between Territorial Employment Centers and employers:
- ✓ In 2014, June-July, 5 young people have industrial practice in Goris/ 3 of them in Areg pharmacy of Emma Aslanyan and Sons LTD, 2 of them in Marine Shalunts LTD pharmacy/ after the practice 3 of them started to work in the relevant field.
- ✓ Since October 1, 11 disabled people and also two young people have practice in P&T LTD newly created sewing workshop.
- ✓ As a result of cooperation with "Goris Women's Development Resource Center Foundation", 5 young people have practice in wool washing center in Shinuhayr community.
- ✓ Within the framework of Sisian Territorial Employment Center state support project, 6 young people have practice, 4 of them started to work.
- ✓ 3 young people have their industrial practice in Tigran Tigranyan PE accounting office.
- ✓ The awareness of Young people, from beneficiary communities, about state support projects by territorial employment centers, was increased.

Unemployed people were found out from rural communities of Goris / Shinuhayr, Khot, Halidzor, Qarahunj/ and directed to the Territorial Employment Center of Goris/ during August-September 35 people were directed to the relevant center, 18 of them have already been registered/.

On August 8, in the scope of the project, a Memorandum, on collaboration directed to the

contribution of professional orientation system in RA, was signed between the "Professional Orientation Methodological Center" SNCO and P&T NGO

Results

Within the framework of the project, 4 four-day LG trainings and 4 two-day computer skill trainings were implemented in beneficiary communities of Syunik and Vayots Dzor regions (Shinuhayr, Qarahunj, Halidzor, Khndzoresk, Sisian, Spandaryan, Ashotavan, Kapan, Artsvanik, Meghri, Vayk, Gomk, Getap, Bardzruni / for the representatives of Community Active Groups / CAG representatives.

The trainings included the following themes:

- ✓ LG Legislation
- ✓ Leadership
- ✓ Strategic Planning
- ✓ Community Budget
- ✓ Procurement Process
- ✓ Participatory and Transparent Management
- ✓ Communication within the LG

Within the framework of the project, 5 one-day advanced trainings were implemented for beneficiary community leaders and LG representatives of RA, Syunik and Vayots Dzor regions.

The advanced trainings included the following themes:

- ✓ Public Speech
- ✓ Community as an Administrative Unit
- ✓ Community Budget
- ✓ Procurement Organization
- ✓ Fundraising

LG capacity building small grants were given to LGs of 3 beneficiary communities: Vayk, Gomq, Qarahunj.

Summarizing the results of the work implemented within the framework of the project, 3 inter-community exchange and 3 training visits were conducted in Qarahunj, Sisian and Vayk communities.

Project Goal

Contribute to accessibility and availability of health services provided to rural communities.

Project Beneficiaries

Residents of 7 rural communities of RA Syunik region (Shinuhayr, Halidzor, Qarahunj, Khndzoresk, Spandaryan, Ashotavan, Artsvanik) 3 rural communities of Tavush region (Aygehovit, Gandzaqar, Lusadzor) and 5 rural communities of Vayots Dzor (Gomq, Bardzruni, Getap, Areni, Herher).

Results

Focus-group discussions and sociological surveys were conducted in 12 beneficiary communities of RA Syunik, Vayots Dzor and Tavush regions to find out the needs of accessibility and availability of healthcare services in rural communities.

Based on the results of focus-group discussions and sociological surveys, the project analysis has been carried out by monitoring and evaluation specialist.

Within the framework of the project, regional forums on "Accessibility and Availability of services provided by Primary Health Care Centers" were organized in Goris, Vayk and Ijevan cities of Syunik, Vayots Dzor and Tavush regions, among participants were representatives of community active groups/ CAG of beneficiary communities, doctors of health clinics and ambulatories, representatives of health care departments of Syunik and Vayots Dzor regional administrations.

The regional forums were aimed at presenting the results of the analysis of focus-group discussions and sociological surveys to the stakeholders and collecting proposals targeted towards the solutions of the issues, on local, regional and national levels. P&T NGO has prepared proposal package based on the collected suggestions, which must be presented to the decision makers.

In the scope of the project, awareness raising campaigns on my right to health care were held in target communities of 3 beneficiary regions, with the active involvement of Community Active Groups and Student Councils.

At the end of the program, a special issue of the newspaper "Kamq" was published on the coverage of the projects implemented in beneficiary regions within the framework of the program.

Results

P&T NGO started the implementation of the program since December, 2013, however, the main activities envisaged by the project were implemented in 2014. In the scope of the project, the assessment of individual needs of disabled people in Goris community is made to clarify possible areas of employment.

Capacity building trainings for public and political activities was provided to 25 disabled people from Goris and neighboring Verishen community.

In order to promote employment of disabled people, P&T NGO, in the scope of “Save the Children International” organization’s “Living Standards Improvement for Employment of disabled people” (LIFE) project, created “LIFE” leather goods production.

As a social entrepreneurship, the creation of “LIFE” leather goods production aims at involving disabled people in public life.

Within the framework of the project, P&T NGO has cooperated with Goris Territorial Employment Center of “State Employment Agency” for the trainings of 15 women, 11 of which are disabled people. After trainings 8 disabled women started to work at the workshop.

During the trainings, women have already learnt how to sew 10 models of leather bags, belts and wallets. The workshop will expand its collection. Disabled people are full of hope, they assure that in recent years this is the first case that they have the opportunity to prove that they can do it.

To raise public awareness of the dangers of interstate highways for school students, a video was broadcasted on Syunik regional television.

Children and parents use appropriate methods to ensure road safety.

Results

E-learning platform, NGOU website is an online platform that lets you participate in online trainings on “team management”, “financial management”, “presentation”, “content design” and “overcoming the set threshold” and get relevant certificate.

Within the framework of the project three working meetings were organized in Yerevan with the participation of the representatives of non-governmental organizations, LGs and international organizations in order to present E-learning platform.

At the initial stage of the project, consultation meetings were held for P&T NGO members to give them some knowledge of how to use the NGOU website.

P&T NGO computer specialist has received appropriate consultation to provide site maintenance. As a result of the consultation P&T NGO Computer Coordinator has downloaded all the programs which gave opportunity to add translated modules in the site, test them and run.

To make the trainings available to RA citizens, P&T NGO has translated them into Armenian and posted on the relevant sections of the site.
